As a follow up to our last communiqué – number 16 – that called on our brothers the youth to sit-in on April 9th in commemoration of the brutal American occupation, we would like to reveal the locations of the sit-ins in Baghdad and Iraqi provinces, and note that it is the right of every honorable Iraqi that is against the occupation and its political system which is built on a sectarian and ethnic quota system, to protest on that sad day, which will also be our day of salvation from this hated occupation. So we can preempt those that are stuck in stagnant water, we ask all our brothers that are part of movements against the occupation from civil society organizations to join this big demonstration and to send us e-mails, call our cell phone numbers (contained in our last communiqué) or message us on the face book pages “Iraq Sees” or “The Great Iraqi Revolution”, so we can add you to the list of co-signers for this action, which we hope, God willing, will be a day of salvation from occupations and its enablers. Locations of the action in Baghdad and the rest of the Iraqi provinces:

- 1) Baghdad – Tahrir Square will be the main meeting place in Baghdad. In the event that Maliki’s forces block our route to this square, the alternative meeting place will be Nisour Square so that our brothers from Karkh can participate.
- 2) Nino Province – the area of the Nino International Airport
- 3) Kirkuk Province – in front of the K-1 air base
- 4) Dhi Qar Province – in front of Imam Ali air base, the headquarters of the occupation forces
- 5) Anbar Province – in front of al-Asad base, in the Baghdadi neighborhood, headquarters of the occupation forces
- 6) Basra Province – in front of the Basra International Airport, the headquarters of the occupation forces
- 7) Amara Province – at al-Fajeera
- 8) Salah al-Deen Province – Balad base
- 9) Diwaniyya Province – in front of the province municipal building
- 10) Al-Kut Province - in front of the province municipal building
